Work performed this week (5-15 thru 5-19):

From 5-15 thru 5-18 the water main has been installed up to the east side of Orchard Court and into the cul-de-sac. The crew stopped for the day around 2:00pm and will commence Monday down Orchard Court.

Work to be performed next week (5-22 thru 5-26):

Malley Construction will be installing water main on the east side of Orchard Court to the north. They anticipate 200'+/- a day and should have Orchard Court completed by the end of the week (5-26).
