Dear Board Members:

As you know, the EPA is funding the cost of providing safe municipal drinking water to homes on Orchard Ct in the Orchard Hills subdivision through a grant to the City of St. Louis. This project will have significant impact on streets and outlawns throughout the subdivision.

- St. Louis sought bids through their engineer (Spicer Group). They received two bids (Malley Construction and Crawford Construction). St. Louis has accepted the lowqualified bid by Malley in the amount of \$2,321,694 plus necessary surveying and inspection services. The projected pre-bid cost was approximately \$1.7 million.
- I have attached the bid breakdown for your review. Pages 1- 3 are all direct costs to the EPA totaling \$2,009,127.91
- Pages 4-5 are there because it makes sense to consider long-term improvements for Orchard Hills while EPA has a contractor on-site. I asked St. Louis and Spicer to add a few feet of 8" water main to the project to close some loops of dead-end 4" water main. On the attached map, you will see two short lines colored in green. By adding these locations, we greatly improve water flow for fire protection and water quality for customers. The water main extensions in green are \$165,514.05
- EPA has agreed to crush, shape, and install new asphalt on all streets in the subdivision.
 They were all installed over 60 years ago. While reviewing the project with the road
 commission, we decided it made sense to replace all of the road culverts at this time.
 Changing culverts includes better swales and catch basins to better control runoff in
 heavy rain events.

Township exposure for these local roads is \$165,514.05 for water main extensions. Drainage improvements are \$144,052.04, with the township splitting the cost with the Road Commission. This brings our construction exposure to \$165,514.05 plus \$72,026.02 for a total construction cost of \$237,540.07. There will be inspection and surveying fees added to this cost, and our share will be proportional. I do not have that projected number yet.

We have sufficient general fund monies to pay for this project. It is also a 100% qualified expenditure of our ARPA money (\$232,456.24).

This project will occur this summer/fall.
