

MINUTES OF THE PINE RIVER TOWNSHIP BOARD
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
SEPTEMBER 13, 2000

1. The regular monthly meeting of the Pine River Township Board was called to order at 7:00 PM by Supervisor VanderVeen at the township hall.
2. The board and guests gave pledge to the flag.
3. Present for Roll Call: Lofgren=yes, Lynn=no, Smith=no, VanderVeen=yes, Loper=yes.
4. There was a motion by Loper, second by Lofgren to approve the agenda as presented. All three board members voted yeah.
5. There was a motion by Loper, second by Lofgren to approve the August 9, minutes as presented. All board members were in favor.
6. Brief public comment. Margaret Parks asked about the progress of cemetery, also asked about Ken Beard lots. Clerk informed her that Mr. Beard would need to contact the township hall to set up an appointment.
7. Motion by Loper, second by Lofgren to pay the bills as presented. Roll call: VanderVeen: yes, Loper: yes, Lofgren: yes. All three in favor.
8. Report by Treasurer, John Loper. Treasurer report placed on file.
9. Discuss before Public Hearing in regards to Berm at Petticoat. Public Hearing was open at 7:15 p.m. Supervisor VanderVeen stated that Blodgett could not have a representative at this meeting. It was the desire of Blodgett Oil to lower the berm to between 4 to 6 feet and add width to it. Also they will plant two rows of Evergreen trees on top. At the Public Hearing it was made aware to the board that the property towards the back was not being maintained. Mr. Rutherford expressed his desire to have the portion of the berm by his property left at least 6 foot high. Public Hearing was closed.
b. There was request to annex GreenStone Farm Credit property on Wright Ave to the City of Alma. There will be a Public Hearing and Advertising Scheduled to cover this at the Regular Monthly Board Meeting on October 11, at 7:15 p.m. at the Pine River Township Hall.
